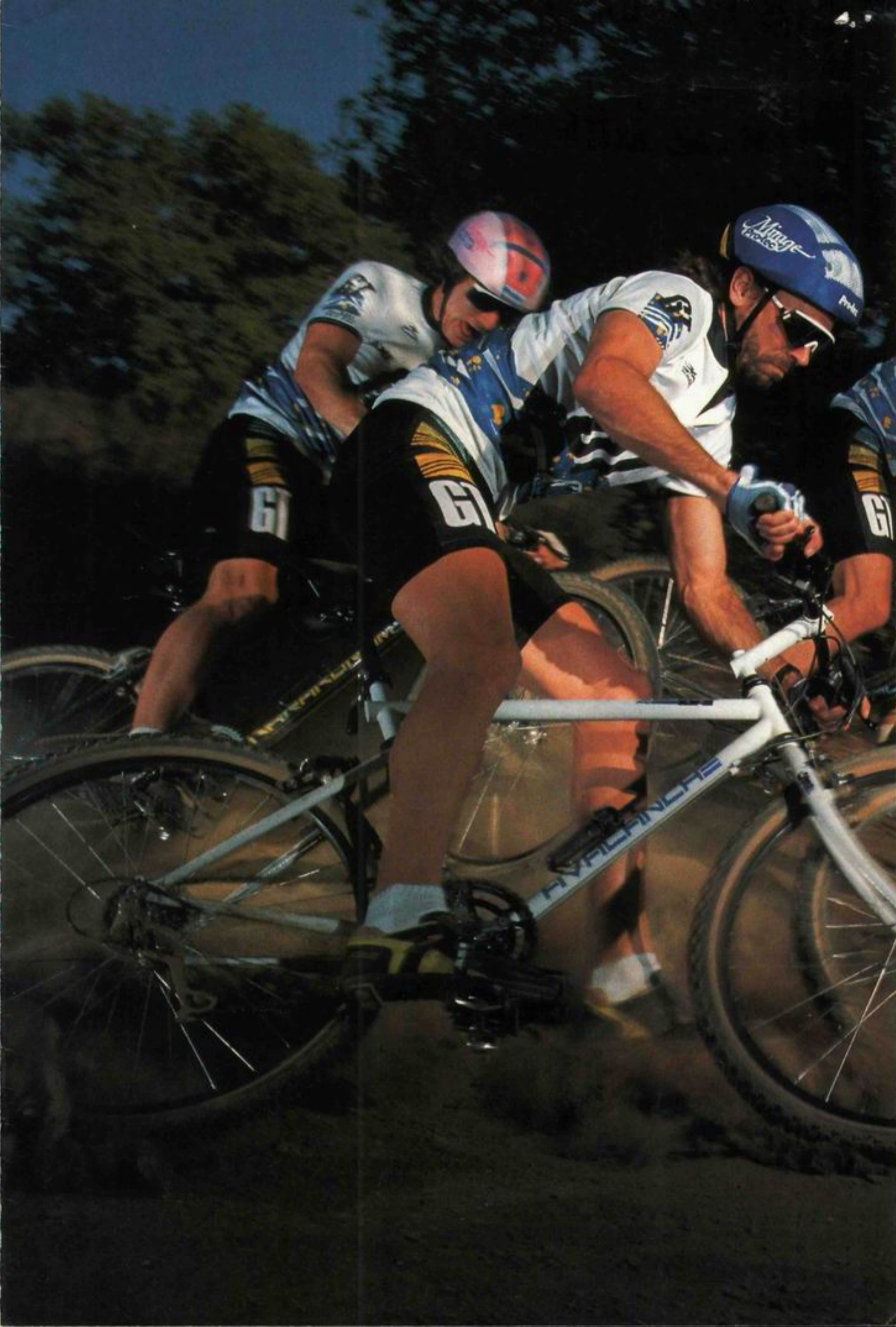

*You probably won't be tracking mud into a professional photo studio, but if tracking in a lot of good times is in your future, here's a few items to make life on the trail a bit more pleasant.*

*GT Instaflate — This CO2 powered life-saver allows you to regulate the air pressure being put into your tube.*

*GT Toe Clips and Straps — There's nothing worse than slippery feet. Cinch them down with the wide clearance of GT Toe Clips and reinforced nylon straps.*
