The Mountain Bike Facts

hat is a Mountain Bike?

A Mountain Bike is a bike capable of climbing over mountains with relative ease, of crossing fields, rivers or even todays tough city streets in fact all terrains - hence 'ATB' or 'All terrain bikes'.

So what makes it different from a conventional bike?

- 1. Fat tyres of 2.125" enable the bike to float over potholes, rocks and even ploughed fields.
- 2. Larger diameter Frame-tubing made from lightweight Chrome-Moly for strength and durability.
- 3. Frame geometry design that has evolved to the characteristic shape of today's Mountain Bikes - ideally suited for controlled crossing of rough terrain.
- 4. Cantilever brakes Test them for yourself - with just one finger pull the front brake lever, lift the rear of the bike and put your full weight behind it - that wheel just won't turn.
- 5. Wide motorbike-styled handlebars for greater control and stability.
- 6. Thumbshifters. You need your hand on the grips to stay in control so where better and safer to have the gearshifters than within reach of your thumbs.
- 7. 18 speed gears. Yes 18 speeds that'll get you climbing the walls - or just climbing that hill in the saddle while others have to get off and push.
- 8. Sealed bearings, sealed headsets and sealed hubs for less maintenance hassle.
- 9. Components of the highest order designed by the world's experts experts in component technology to cope with the ever inceasing demands of the Mountain Bike rider.
- 10. Overall a heavy-duty tough vet deceptively light bike that is in a different league from any other bike on or off the roads!
