Fat City Cycles, Somerville, MA, is proud to introduce the 1986 Fat Chance. Race bred, this ultimate-quality off-road machine offers the same unique geometry that has gotten previous marques rave reviews from racers and weekend riders alike. Completely handbuilt, from a custom tube set of American-made 4130 Chrome-moly, the precisely engineered combination of head tube angle (69°), short top tube, moderately steep seat tube (72°) and short, stiff chainstays gives real power for acceleration and climbing and real confidence in descents. Plasma welding is used throughout and all welds are guaranteed.

The 1986 Fat Chance features handbuilt race wheels spinning on sealed-bearing hubs, and the specially-designed, sealed and servicable bottom bracket uses a Cook Bros. Chrome-Moly spindle. Componentry consists of a performance-tested mix of the best from Suntour, Shimano, Sugino, Tange, and Magura. Braze-on's include slotted cable guides and two bottle cages.

The Fat Chance Mountain Bike is available in frame sizes of 15, 16.5, 18, 19.5, 21, and 23 inches. Standard colors are red or black with an Imron custom option. Total unit weight is 27 pounds (with 19° frame). Suggested retail, at quality bicycle dealers everywhere, is \$ 849.
