



his is our tenth year in business and what a decade it's been! When we look back at our first FAT CHANCE and then at our line-up for '92, we can't help but glow with pride.



Ten years ago, the tubing that was available for off road frames was heavy. And the selection was minimal. So, Chris designed a triple butted tubeset that True Temper drew for us. Since then, we've further refined our tubesets and those original tubes are widely sold by True Temper to other bicycle manufacturers, both large and small.

There are other details, such as our double chin aussets, that we sell to framebuilders like Salsa for use on their bikes. And other manufacturers have requested our chain and seatstays, with and without the domed ends, but we've declined selling them!

What Fat City has done over the years has been copied and assimilated into many of the bikes you'll see out on the trail. You'll find bits and pieces of our ideas here and there. But the only way to get it all is to get one of our bikes. After all, we're Fat City. The One.- The Only.

# 1992 FAT CITY BICYCLES

This year, we've got four mountain bikes and one road bike in our line-up. Each is built by hand from start to finish. Of course, we do use some tools! Like lasers, lathes and welding machines. And each of our bikes is carefully handled and inspected during every phase of production.

We've always offered options for you to customize your bike and this year is no exception. Our "stock" bikes are described below with options listed on the next two pages. Should you not find what you need, please ask your Fat City dealer or call us directly. Here's to your new bike!

#### **IOTH ANNIVERSARY FAT CHANCE**

This is our tenth year in business and the 10th Anniversary Fat is the culmination of all the things Fat City is about. The frameset's really light; built with a new custom designed superlight True Temper OX3 tubeset, the frame weighs about 4 pounds -- and the 1" Yo Eddy! fork weighs about a pound and a half. That's a quarter pound lighter than its brother! We're only building 150 of these bikes. Each will have an anodized titanium head tube badge, Campy's 1992 Record OR components and a weight of less than 23 pounds. Specs are the same as the Yo Eddy! except for the 1" diameter fork blades and the lighter weight. Available as a bicycle only in silver with violet and cleared over decals.

### YO EDDY! TEAM FAT CHANCE

Germany's BIKE magazine called this the best bike they'd ever ridden. Period. We hesitate to quote them verbatim 'cause they wrote it in German. The Yo! is built with quad butted heat treated True Temper tubing and plenty of mud clearance, oversized tubes, a tight rear triangle (16 7/8" chainstays) and the original Yo Eddy! fork with 1.5" of rake. It features a 71 degree head tube angle, 72 degree seat tube angle and an 11 7/8" bottom bracket height, as do all of our mountain bikes. The Yo! is available in black, yellow, metallic teal and kandy wild cherry as a frameset or a bike with Shimano XTR components.

#### MONSTER FAT

Our '92 Monster has many of the features of our Yo Eddy! -- 16 7/8" chainstays, top tube cable routing, sloping top tube -- and a rear triangle that's simpler to build so we pass the savings on to you. The fork is a variation of our Yo Eddy! fork, built by Tange with Yo Eddy!'s endorsement. Available as a bike with Shimano DX components or a frameset in black only.

### WICKED FAT CHANCE


MOUNTAIN BIKE ACTION picked this bike as one of the ten best bikes for 1991.

And BICYCLE GUIDE wrote that "it is almost beyond comparison". The Wicked features superb balance, nimble steering and smaller diameter frame tubes that contribute to a more forgiving ride. It's responsive both on the road and off, and we believe it's an exceptionally good design for all around use. Available in black, yellow, metallic teal and kandy wild cherry as a frameset or a bike with Shimano XTR components.

# SLIM CHANCE

Lightweight elegance; the Slim is the result of Fat City's expertise and technology coupled with Chris' five years of custom road framebuilding experience. It's the best of both worlds. Built with Columbus TSX tubing and our new EL unicrown fork, it's available as a bike with Mavic components or a frameset in black, yellow, metallic teal and kandy wild cherry with cleared over decals.






