Specialized Bicycle Components ("Specialized") makes the following Limited Warranty:

ONE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY ON COMPLETE BICYCLE

Specialized warrants to the original owner that this new Specialized bicycle shall be free of defective materials and workmanship for a period of one year from the date of the original purchase provided the bicycle is purchased in the United States and operated under normal conditions and use. During this one-year warranty period, Specialized shall repair or replace, at its sole option, all parts that are found by Specialized to be defective and subject to this limited warranty. The original owner shall pay all labor charges connected with the repair or replacement of all parts.

LIFETIME LIMITED WARRANTY ON BICYCLE FRAME

Specialized further warrants to the original owner that the frame of this new Specialized bicycle shall be free of defective materials or workmanship during the lifetime of the original owner. During this lifetime warranty period, Specialized shall repoir or replace, at its sole option, the bicycle frame if Specialized determines the frame is defective and subject to this limited warranty. The original owner shall pay all labor charges connected with the repoir or replacement of the bicycle frame.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

This Limited Warranty is made only to the original owner of this new Specialized bicycle, and it shall remain in force only as long as the original owner retains ownership of the Specialized bicycle. This Limited Warranty is not transferable.

In order to obtain service under this Limited Warranty, the original owner must deliver the Specialized bicycle to an authorized Specialized dealer, together with the Specialized warranty card and the bill-of-sale or other dated proof-of-purchase document identifying the Specialized bicycle by frame number.

This Limited Warranty does not apply to normal wear or tear, nor to defects, malfunctions or failures that result from the abuse, neglect, improper maintenance, alteration, modification, accident, or misuse finding, without limitation, bicycle racing, bicycle motocross, stunt bicycling or similar activities) of the Specialized bicycle.

This limited warranty is the only express or limited warranty applicable to specialized bicycles. Any implied warranties, including warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, shall be limited in scope and duration in accordance with this limited warranty. Specialized shall not be responsible for any direct, incidental, consequential or exemplary damages suffered by any party. The foregoing statements of warranty are exclusive and in lieu of all other remedies.

This limited warranty gives you specific legal rights, you may also have other legal rights which vary from state to state. Some states do not allow limitations on the duration of implied warranties, or the limitation or exclusion of incidental or consequential damages; therefore, the limitations and exclusions set forth in this limited warranty may not apply to you.

The limited warranty set forth herein may not be extended, enlarged or otherwise modified by any specialized dealer, agent or employee, and Specialized does not assume any liability or make any warranty except as stated in this limited warranty.



You don't make it in world class cycle racing without putting a few demands on yourself. Just check out the Specialized Allez. To lighten the frame without giving up strength, we designed ovalized tubing right up to the seat lug and bottom bracket — a move that required precision custom lugsets that can handle an oval tube. Still not satisfied, we tapered the lug points to reduce thickness where it meets the lug, for a uniform joint with less stress risers. The bottom line is a maximized steel frame that, at 1.6 kg, blows away handmade Italian bikes costing lillions more.

The frame tube is composed of multiple layers of unidirectional carbon fiber sheets. The number and direction of the layers depends on the ride characteristics desired for that section of tube; extra stiffness for speed, frame flex to absorb bumps, etc. Put simply, the whole tube is designed specifically for it's function. We call it Programmed Stiffness. You'll call it just plain wicked.





- Yield trail to hikers and equestrians. Slow down to their speed when passing.
- When approaching a horse from the rear, slow down and ask the rider how best to proceed.
- Don't skid. Neither a safe nor efficient way to ride, it can degrade the trail surface.
- Obeu all speed limits. Reduce speed in blind turns.
- Avoid extremelu muddu areas.
- Wear a helmet.
- Be prepared. Carry a spare tube and pump, tools, adequate food and water, small first aid kit, etc.
 Hnow your abilities and your planned route.
- Hnow which trails and areas are open to cyclists. Don't assume that a trail is open, even if it isn't signed accordingly.




