


all new and redesigned for 1994. the si is our racer with features you'll only find on bikes costing hundreds of dollars more. for '94 we stretched the 4130 chromoly frame to Pro X dimensions. we added our amazingly light race lite bars, two-piece disc drive sprocket, improved cantilever braking. oversized pedals, and pad set.



Last year we shook up the BIAX world by going with rear canti brakes on the Si. This year we've gone one bester. We redesigned the machined aluminum arms for greater stiffness. We even added a new allen anchor bolt and quick release link wise for easy adjustment and wheel changes. For '94 the Si is the frastest stopping bike on the race track, period.




New for 1994: Fusion Race Lite 6061 T-6 allay handlebars with clamp-on crossbar. At 1lbs. 4 oz. our new Roce Lite bar is one half a pound lighter than comparable chromoly bars! Total weight on the SI race ready with pads and plate is an incredible 23 lbs. 8 oz!




The Right Lever is key to high performance

New for 1994: our Fusion 2-piece alloy Roce Disc sprocket. It features a smaller six balt radius instead of the conventional five. Combine this with increased sprocket thickness and forged spider and you've got one of the most flex free racing chainings available today. Out of the gate and down the first straight you'll definetly feel the difference!





popular race bike.

at most bike companies they would have just changed the color and decal and called it "a '94." not at haro. for '94 we started by dropping the weight three

quarters of a pound thanks to our fusion alloy micro-adjust

seat post, disc drive alloy sprocket and acs alloy hubs. then we added our new stealth haro racing seat and race ready pad set. if you want to start racing, simply zip tie a number plate on and sign-up.



Group 1Cl is also available in chrome.



New for '94...Fusion alloy Disc Drive 44T chointing. It weighs in at an incredibly light 4 ounces! That's one half pound lighter than a steel sprocket/steel spider combinations found on our competitor's bilkes in this price mane!

the '94 Ci will do the rest.

so if you want to get out there and race but don't know where to start... start with a t1.





The '94 Ti comes stock with our Fusion stem precision CNC machined from solid 7075 aluminum billet . Shaft is 4130 chromoly steel. All bolts are the highest Grade 8 Aircraft standard Finish is minor like high polish, It's so beautiful it's a shame we cover it with a race ready nylon /foom stem pad. The Ti even comes equipped with top tube and crossbar pads



The only thing faster stopping than one Dia-Compe Bulldog caliper and MX 122 lever is TWO. That's right , we've equipped this year's Ti with front AND rear Bulldoas for awesome braking power. Coupled with oversized unicrown fork and rear monostay you've got flex-free stopping fore and aft.

and beefed UP the forks, added OVErsize seat stays, chainstays

and pegs. so really ,the 1994 master has everything the sport's legends came to expect from it, plus some cool, new refinements.



Most every Master we sell isn't just ridden...It's lived on, so only the highest quality, longest lasting equipment will do. Like our time proven Pro Tovaitle, Kneesover handlebors, XL clear kraton grips and Dio Compe's Tech 77 cold forged allay levers with stopper buttons.

New for '94...Fusion oversized 1.5" diameter 4" long chromoly pegs. They

begin life two pieces of precisioned machined chromoly. The two pieces

become one via a ten ton hydraulic press. Then they're oven brazed to cement the precision press fit. Finally they're hard chrome plated for

consistently fast grinds on all surfaces.

Die Compe's AD 990 U-brake features fully adjustable arm return spring fension and independent brake pod loe-in and post adjustments. 


