

eti Cycles, Inc. was born in the fall of 1985, when John Parker sold "Beulah Mae," a 1928 Indian motorcycle, for a frame fixture and an armful of chromoly tubing. This fateful turn of





events came after crashing a midget race car and suffering serious injuries. John

and wife Linda, were forced to make a transition from the Special Effects world of the Hollywood Studios to the humble beginnings of Yeti Cycles.

While Linda was making ends meet as an elementary school teacher, John was dreaming up the future of the latest arrival to the budding mountain bike industry. He promptly began putting the Yeti wheels in motion in the back of Matt Sweeney's Special Effects Shop.

Things began to move quickly in the fast-paced mountain bike circuits of Southern California. John welcomed partners Chris Herting and Frank "FTW" Wadelton to assist in the fabrication of what were rapidly



becoming known as some of the highest quality, most innovative racing frames available to the growing MTB market. Shortly after Matt Sweeney kicked Parker and Yeti out of his shop, a small facility in Agoura Hills, CA was producing hundreds of "Handmade in the

USA," chromoly and Easton aluminum framesets. After winning two gold medals at the inaugural 1990 UCI World Mountain Bike Championships, we decided to relocate our entire operation and staff of twelve to the self-proclaimed Mountain Bike Mecca of the World: Durango, Colorado, U.S.A.

Once settled in our new, 10,000-square-foot digs, Yeti set about the task of increasing the production of our race-winning, chromoly and aluminum hardtail frames. With one of the finest testing grounds in the universe right in our own backyard, Yeti designed two of the best performing full-suspension frames in the business. As the Yeti name became better and better known, we




further developed an extensive line of accessories and softgoods that are now in high demand around the globe.





You won't find any caution signs or flagmen on this Road Project, just a flat-out flyer from the folks known for building Mountain Bikes. The Yeti Road Project sports traditional, size-specific


geometry, but don't be fooled, there's nothing else traditional about it. "With its big caterpillar welds, oversize aluminum tubes, and bent chainstays, it sure doesn't look like a '70s Colnago. But it rides that way, and it weighs less than 3 pounds. Merckx should have been so lucky." - January 1995 - BICYCLING. Our ability to specify Custom tube kits from Easton allows us to build a frame that rides like no other. A silky smooth road feel with super efficient lateral stiffness makes for a frame that can be ridden all day, but will handle the out-of-the-saddle field sprints to the city limits sign or across the finish line without sawing your front derailleur in half. Come on, just because we build great Mountain Bikes doesn't mean we don't know our way around the road!




