Four Bar Linkage



For a long time you ask is "Why do I need a dual suspension like this and what is it for?"

The early ratio center travel, suspension control, don't get you yourself. The rear suspension makes a better shock absorber than absorbs big and small hits. Helps in much with the ground, especially when the shock absorber has a return rate, downshifts a vehicle.

The front four bar linkage design delivers fast ride and performance. The design concept works across the board from downhill to flat or cross-country. The wheels are similar to the components in the size and weight of frame and shock components. More is how and why it works. 1. The 4 bars. 2. Centering System. 3. Shock Absorber. 4. Four Bar Linkage. 5. Dropouts and tubes for high strength and rigidity. 6. Cold forged swingarm. 7. The rear shock does not get increased by providing a supportive function, which reduces strain. 8. Rear shock is longer and by the bottom link pivot and rear axle, not a small character point. 9. Disc brake mounts in chainstay to ensure a strong fixing point. 10. Four bar system allows us to fine tune the leverage ratio, too, shock can be lowered in the optimum position to keep pedalling forces from affecting suspensions

Easton RAD tubing

Riding style have evolved over the years and the demands placed on the frames have increased. Long road and track-style frames have increased the stress a frame must withstand - especially in the head tube area. Easton's way is a new tube called RAD. The tube is round or oval at the seat tube and draws into a rectangular section at the head tube. When a RAD-tube is joined to a standard tube, the resulting cross section is large and stronger in our vibration test than anything we've ever broken. Large side plate gussets and big welds are all required.



There are some French riders out there who don't like the name of this bike. Because, it means crash in their language. Come to think of it, you might be doing quite a bit of that on this bike. That's why it's overbuilt. It's another Out of Bounds bike, like the other ones on this page.

The bikes follow the riders that build the new trails. Yesterday's craziness has become routine. What was unrideable is now do-able with gaps and logs to clear, free falls, and jumps. Big air and first descents of unrideable rock faces are there for the taking. It's not a lunatic fringe, doing the impossible. No obstacle is sacred on the mountain or in the concrete jungle. There are stairways, retaining walls, ramps, loading docks to be cleared with air.

Kona has been producing hydraulic and mechanical disc brakes since 1988 for caravans. The Hayes Hydraulic system is made with a zinc Master Cylinder body. Stainless Steel disc and a Nylon woven hydraulic hose. Braking is equally reliable and consistent in wet and dry conditions with no fading. The unique multi-disc friction material brake pads adjust and retract so there's no free-rotating drag plus they can be changed without tools.


The usual trade-off in an Out of Bounds fork is increased torsional rigidity with a double-clamp system, but we didn't want a huge answer is to integrate a longy 26mm thru-axle into the design. This unique QR20 system provides the torsional rigidity where it is most needed at the front wheel, but allows full steering freedom.

Rock Shox was the first company to produce front suspension for bicycles and is still the leader in performance for lightweight race forks. This year's SID "Superlight Integrated Design" series features the highest efficiency of adjustable suspension, balanced with the plushness of oil-air lubrication. SID Race, featured on the King Kula bike weighs 2.5lbs and SID SL, featured on the Explosif is 2.7 lbs. Both have 100mm of travel and Dual Air chambers, providing excellent tunability. SID XC (2.8lbs) featured on the Kona and King Kula, has 100mm of travel, external valving & compression adjusters. Easton EA70 rims & tires, external valving & compression adjusters. Easton EA70 upper tubes and one piece Magneum lower tubes.

Banzien's on the job, late night - Napa, California. Thanks, Buddy.

Banzien starts working on these bicycles this where other tube makers stop. Through a unique cold-working process they produce a tube with a wider differential between the thickest and thinnest sections. Metal is thicker where it is needed to increase strength, yet smoothly tapered to super thin wall sections to reduce weight. The key is that by tapering disrupts shock down the tube - making the ride more comfortable and the frame more durable. An additional benefit is that the grain structure of the aluminum is more refined, which also increases the strength of the material. Easton Ultralite is featured on the Kona, Phatshen, King Kula.
