

C-16R

The development of the C16R is intertwined with the history of Orange mountain bikes. The first prototypes of the Clockwork were seen in 1988 and instantly caught the attention of mountain bike gurus. When released into production in '89, it became the bike of the year winning the British Championships powered by Tim Davies.

The C16R maintains the same integrity as the Clockwork but with sixteen generations of refinement. So, although the C16R features one inch head tube and power stay wishbone

> seatstays, a hallmark of all Orange frames, the cromoly Series 7.2 tubeset is customised to retain the strength but cut back the weight. To the untrained eye, the slightly bigger tubed C16R may look like only the name has been trimmed down, yet the Orange aficionado will realise the C16R LX is over three lbs lighter than the original Clockwork LX. Yet whatever the terrain, from the gnarliest to the steepest, the smooth efficient ride has passed down the generations.

The C16R is the ultimate all round performer.



Aluminium frames have been around since the early development of the mountain bike. In theory, an aluminium frame is the ideal solution - light, stiff and strong. In practice, however, the huge oversize tubes needed to give the frame its strength also give a harsh, uncomfortable ride which can hammer the rider.

We, at Orange have refined the design of the aluminium frame. The E3 is the latest development of the Orange Elite range. Sobtle detail changes and constant improvement ensure that the E3 is years ahead of the competition. By fabricating with Series 9 Max tubing, where each individual tube is the correct balance of profile and thickness we have produced a bike which has all the benefits of aluminium but is not overly harsh. In fact the E3 is praised for its rider comfort, unique for an aluminium frame. Combine the Series 9 Max tubing with the Es s no compromise design and geometry and you have a bike

which is equally at home on the race circuit or mountain trail and "rides like someone has flattened out the bumps." Performance without compromise



If ever there was a bike built to be hammered it's the P7. The unique combination of strength and stiffness provides a crash resistant chassis capable of handling severe off road use and abuse.


When we designed the P7 we moved away from the "lightweight at all cost" approach to bike design, with our goal being to build the ultimate performance steel frame for the hard core mountain biker. By close attention to

detail and specifying the profile of each individual tube of the Series 8 microbutted tubing we have placed the metal in the tubeset to give a frame which is light yet incredibly strong.

The P7's ability to handle the severest off road condition is legendary with praise coming from every independent test it's taken part in. In fact we will finish our description purely from what's been printed in the press.

Orange 3AL - 2.5V Series T Seamless is designated Grade 9 quality, and as such, is of the highest strength. This is the only titanium whose performance backs up the reputation of the material, by offering incredible strength, fatigue

resistance and the ability to stay looking good forever. We looked long and hard at the problems and assets of the material uses and have added something new to the titanium frame wars. With its unique wishbone rear stays. Vit T2 gives a ride with punch and rigidity. Its clean lines, sharp handling, rapid response and tough construction make it the top choice for a race or high performance bike. It's a chassis which excels when push comes to shove

There are alternative components available and we spend a considerable amount of time evaluating performance and making supe that any components we fit can withstand the demands of both mountain bike racing and long distance touring





















SAT ON OUR BUTTS
